#### **HUMAN RIGHTS ABUSES IN NEW TURKEY**

- Mothers are not allowed to nurse their babies during custody.
- Mothers with infant babies are also sent to jail.
- More than 700 babies, under age of six in jails.
- More than 17,000 women are in pretrial detention in jails.

#### FROM DELIVERY ROOM TO PRISON



Fadime Gunay was detained on the day after her delivery. While she was giving birth at the hospital, the police awaited to detain her. She, along with her baby, was brought to the courthouse the next day.

Ayse Kaya was detained on the same day of her delivery in Istanbul on July 25. She was transferred to a Police Station in Edirne, 240 km away from Istanbul.



#### **INCARCERATION DURING PREGNANCY**




**Nurhayat Yıldız** has miscarried her twins in a prison and the dead bodies of her babies have not been returned to any of her family members. It was reported that while she was pregnant, Nurhayat Yıldız was kept along with 25 other female inmates in a prison cell in Sinop which is supposed to fit only 8 people. After the tragedic event Yıldız has started to suffer psychological trauma and barely talks.

**Büşra Atalay** a pregnant woman with 6 month of twin babies, was detained by in İstanbul. Atalay, who puked while police began to take the statement, was taken to the Medicalpark Hospital. The mother who was in the early birth process was taken to the emergency caesarean surgery. During this process she lost one of her babies, the girl. The other baby is reportedly in intensive care. The police awaits at the door in order to detain.



#### **Aysenur Parildak**

28 years old journalist was sentenced to 7.5 years in prison. She was charged for having worked at Zaman, Gulen newspaper, and has been under arrest since August 11, 2016. She wrote a letter to Cumhuriyet about solitary confinement and sexual harassment in October 2016. This action led to a ban on letters being sent from Silivri prison.



**Zehra Doğan**, artist and editor of the all-women Kurdish news agency, JINHA, shut down in October 2016, is serving a jail sentence of almost 3 years for a painting and news articles. She wrote from Diyarbakır prison:

"I am in prison but I am not a prisoner. Every day we are showing that art and journalism cannot not be incarcerated. We will continue our struggle and we will continue to say 'journalism is not a crime' until all journalists are free."


