Ayşenur Parıldak, a 27 years old passionate lawyer and journalist from now-closed Zaman Daily has been in jail for more than 27 months as of April 2019 and was sentenced to 7.5 years.

In September, 2017 Vigdis Freedom Foundation an Oslo-based organization awarded Parıldak with its inaugural Shahnoush courage award.

Turkey, the world's leading jailer of journalists, shut down at least 155 media outlets and made mass imprisonments of press members due to their work after the coup attempt in July, 2016. As of January 1, 2019, 176 journalists, editors and media managers are in jail according to U.S Department of State Country Report 2018 and 612,317 investigations (some 45,000 of them are against social media users) have been carried out after so-called coup attempt according to the Turkish Ministry of Justice.
